Jingle or 3DTrees

You will need 2 meters of Christmas fabric, a small to medium print not directional. You can use any color that you wish, I have made them in Black, gold, silver, blue, green, red, white etc. your choice.

You will also need the following:
Sewing machine with new needle thread to match your fabric.
Cutting board and ruler
45mm Rotary cutter w/wavy blade - you can order the wavy blade,
from Tom's Sewing, I have also seen them at Walmart.

Stuffing for the tree, I buy cheap pillows from Walmart they are usually \$5.00 each you will need 1 1/2 you could split the cost with a friend and share 3 between you. Please do not bring used pillows they do not work.

A regular hot glue gun with lots of glue, please do not bring the mini glue guns as they do not work.

Assorted bells, mini ornaments, Christmas buttons, ribbon 1/8" to 1/4" matching your fabric. Mini lights I buy most of my decorations at the Dollar store, Walmart or Micheals. I will also be bringing my collection of decorations and am willing to sell them at cost.

I will be supplying the tree stand and pattern, at the cost of \$10.00 payable the day of the class.


